# **HAUNTED HOUSE**


### **NEXT MEETING SEPTEMBER 16 after** Campground meeting



**V-J Day**, or Victory over Japan Day, marks the end of World War II and is recognized on August 14th in the United States, though the formal surrender documents were signed on September 2nd. The day signifies the surrender of Japan to the Allied forces, officially ending the war.

In the United States, **Patriot Day** occurs on September 11 of each year in memory of the victims killed in the September 11 terrorist attacks in 2001. The flag of the United States is flown at half-staff at the White House and on all U.S. government buildings and establishments throughout the world; Americans are also encouraged to display flags in and outside their homes. Additionally, a moment of silence is observed to correspond with the attacks, beginning at 8:46 a.m. (Eastern Daylight Time), the time the first plane, American Airlines Flight 11, struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001

The **U.S. Air Force** was officially established on September 18, 1947, and has since proven itself as an unrivaled force in aviation. Between 1909 - when that the US military purchased its first aircraft - and 1947, the U.S. Air Force did not exist as a separate and independent military service organization. It went through a series of designations: Aeronautical Section, Signal Corps (1909); Aviation Section, Signal Corps (1914); United States Army Air Service (1918); United States Army Air Corps (1926), and United States Army Air Forces (1941).

In 1947, President Harry S. Truman signed the National Security Act, which not only established this new defense organization but also marked the formal creation of the U.S. Air Force as a separate and independent service branch.

Gold Star Mother's Day is an annual observance that was established by Senate Joint Resolution 115 of June 23, 1936 (49 Stat. 1985 as amended). The last Sunday in September is designated as Gold Star Mother's Day. In 2009 and 2010 it was proclaimed as Gold Star Mother's and Families' Day, and since 2011 as Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day
