This is an opportunity of a lifetime. Don't let it pass you up! Fill out the form (pg. 3) and turn it in to any Chapter Board member!


## **MOOSE of the MONTH** **SANTA CLAUS**



## Valued Veterans

Significant battles during the month of January  
**American Revolutionary War**

**Battle of Princeton (Jan 3, 1777):** A surprise attack by Washington's troops after crossing the Delaware, boosting American morale.

### War of 1812

**Battle of New Orleans (Jan 8, 1815):** A decisive American victory under Andrew Jackson, securing the vital port.

### American Civil War

- **Battle of Stones River (Dec 31, 1862 - Jan 2, 1863):** A bloody tactical draw in Tennessee, one of the war's costliest battles.

- **Mud March (Jan 1863):** General Burnside's failed attempt to cross the Rappahannock River, a frustrating winter campaign for the Union.

**Secession-Related Actions (Jan 1861):** Southern states began seizing federal forts and arsenals, leading up to secession.

### World War II

- **Battle of the Bulge (Ended Jan 25, 1945):** Hitler's final major offensive in the West, ending in a decisive Allied victory after heavy fighting.

- **Operation Bodenplatte (Jan 1, 1945):** A large German air attack aimed at crippling Allied airfields, costly for the Luftwaffe.

- **Siege of Leningrad (Lifted Jan 27, 1944):** Soviet forces finally broke the nearly 900-day German siege, saving the city.

**Battle of Monte Cassino (Began Jan 17, 1944):** A prolonged and brutal battle for a strategic hill in Italy.

### Vietnam War

**Cu Chi Attack (Jan 19, 1968):** A mortar attack on a U.S. base camp, highlighting the intensity of the war.
