D DAY - On June 6, 1944, Allied forces launched D-Day—the Normandy landings—opening a Western front against Nazi Germany with amphibious and airborne assaults across five beaches (Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, Sword); the operation, codenamed Operation Overlord, involved meticulous planning, vast naval and air support, and heavy casualties but established a crucial foothold that ultimately led to the liberation of Western Europe.

ARMY BIRTHDAY - The U.S. Army's birthday, observed on June 14, marks the 1775 establishment of the Continental Army by the Continental Congress and is celebrated with ceremonies, formal balls, cake-cutting, award presentations, and events that honor the Army's history, traditions, and the service of its soldiers.

FLAG DAY - Flag Day in the United States, observed on June 14, commemorates the adoption of the Stars and Stripes as the national flag by the Continental Congress in 1777; it honors the flag's symbolism of national unity and sacrifice with ceremonies, parades, flag-raising events, and educational programs that teach the history and proper care of the flag.

NATIONAL PTSD AWARENESS DAY - National PTSD Awareness Day, observed on June 27 in the United States, raises public understanding of post-traumatic stress disorder, reduces stigma, and promotes access to screening, evidence-based treatment, and support for veterans, first responders, survivors of violence, and others affected; established by Congress to encourage education, early intervention, and community resources that aid recovery.

HAUNTED HOUSE

The Haunted House Committee will meet on Friday June 5th at 4:00 PM continuing our planning of this year's event and we need volunteers. The winter left the trail battered, and with the weather improving, now is the time to clear broken limbs and remove discarded/damaged materials and spread the wood chips.

We're finalizing the maze at this meeting to be prepared well in advance. If we get enough help, we'll be expanding the trail and adding new scenes to increase spacing between them and boost the overall atmosphere and spook factor.

Volunteers are needed for many roles - trail maintenance, scene construction, setting up the Haunted House walls (Sept 19 & 20), decorating rooms in the Haunted House (Sept 20-Oct 2), parking on event nights, and monitoring the trail and animatronics during the events. You don't have to dress up or scare anyone, unless you want to. We also need monitors that will ensure patrons move safely and that animations and props are working, if they aren't then contact trail members to fix issues without disrupting visitors.

If you can spare time this summer to help with trail expansion, building "log cabin" scenes, decoration, or event staffing, please volunteer - your support will make this year's Haunted House our best yet.
