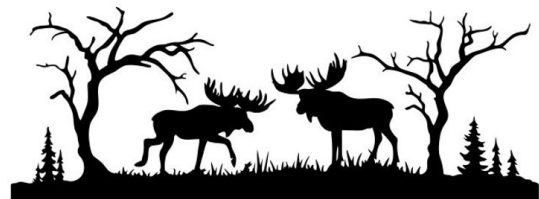
## MOOSE of the Month Joy "Jay" Wesseley

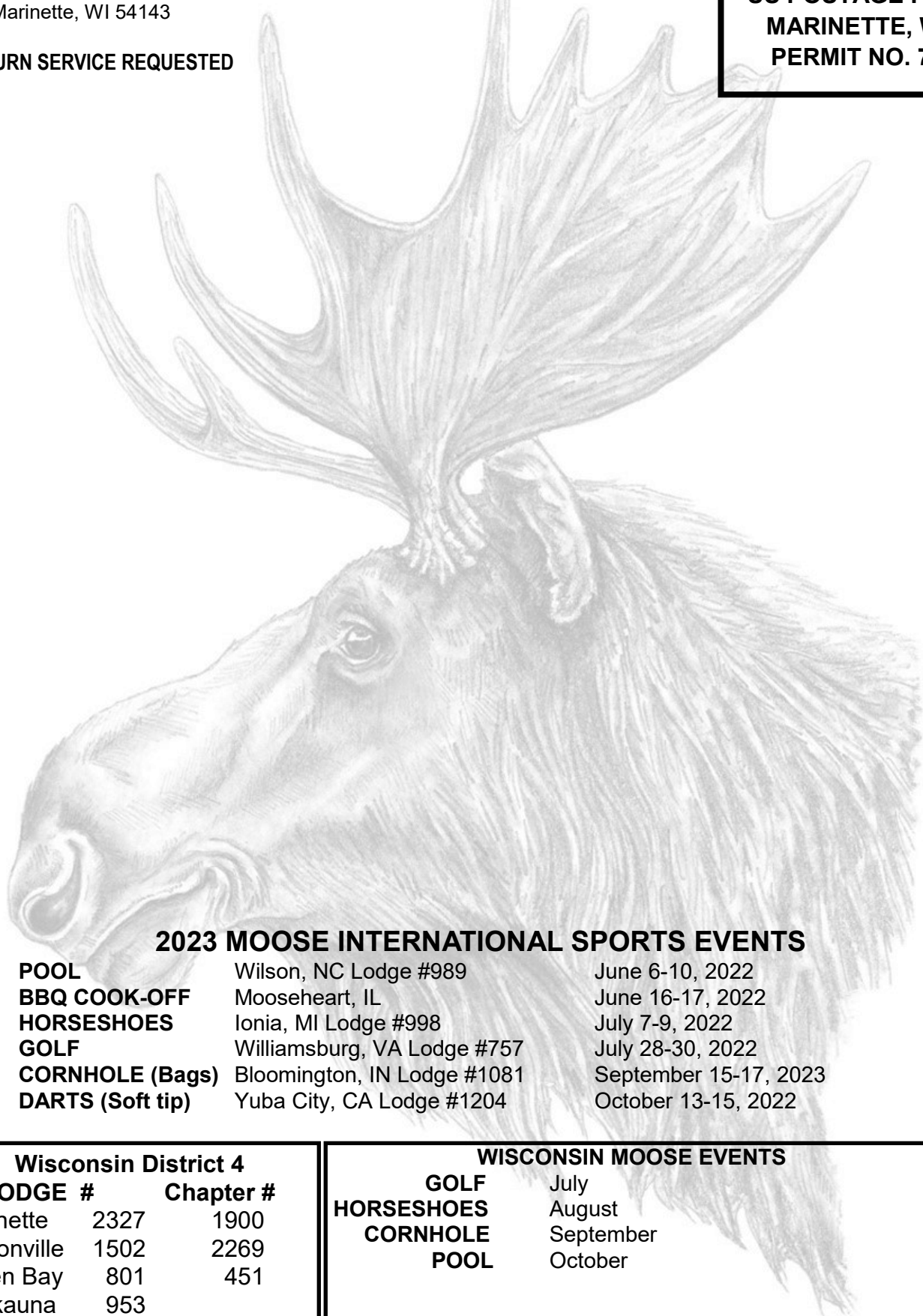
