Congratulations to our Moosette of the month Sara Techmeier. We appreciate all you do for the W.O.T.M.

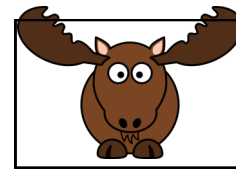

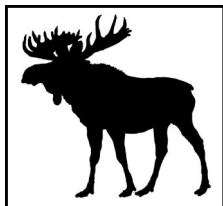
