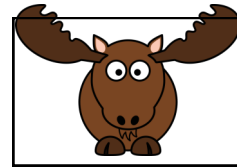

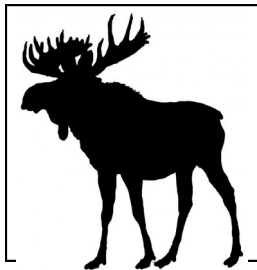
Dart Ball Tournament
