I hope everyone stays safe. Before long the camp ground will be open. Time goes fast.

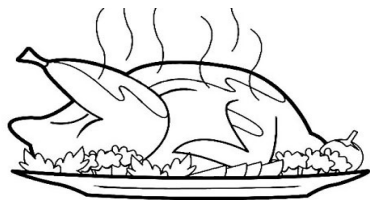

On December 15, 2020 the Marinette moose Lodge rang the bell for the Salvation Army to help raise funds for their Red Kettle drive.

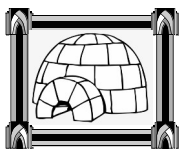

CAMPGROUND NEWS

Last month, the dates for the campground meeting listed Thursday as the meeting dates and this is incorrect. Campground meetings are held at 11:00 AM the third **Saturday** of the month. The dates of the meetings were correct:

April 17	July 17
May 15	August 21
June 19	September 18

Please put these dates in your planner to attend the very informative Campground meetings.

Those already with a camp site need to complete and return your Camp ground rules (Mailed in January) along with your deposit of \$100 by **March 1, 2021** to retain your site. If you are planning on moving to a new site, please make sure to complete that form too. Make sure the forms are completed, **including signature** along with your proof of insurance, on your camper and golf cart or carts. Full payment of \$850 must be received by May 1, 2021 or be assessed a \$25 late fee.

If you have decided not to return, please complete the site vacancy slip stating that you are not

returning. And sign the slip. This will make everything go smoother during the Campground camper meeting on March 28th 2021. The meeting will start at 11:00 AM. If you have a campsite, the letter will be your only letter reminding you of your obligations. The newsletter will try to keep you up to date of camping news.

The campground committee will meet in March to review paid deposits. **If your deposit is not received by March 1st, then your site will be considered vacant.**

CAMPGROUND MEETING 3/28/21. NEXT MONTH is the Annual Campground meeting for moving sites, and filling vacant sites.

If Covid Restrictions are lifted;

If you are on the Campsite waiting list, and you get selected for a camp site, you must have your deposit money turned in the day of the campground meeting.

If you can't be present, then you must have a representative with the deposit money. This way you can have your site reserved.

If Covid Restriction are still in place;

The Campground committee will meet and **CALL** the campsites, by seniority, to fill any moves available

Then **CALL** the Moose Members, in good standing, on the waiting list to fill the open sites.

ONE MOOSE A REALITY!

May 1, 2021

During the 132nd Meeting of the Supreme Lodge, delegates voted favorably to pass a set of General Law Amendments that would essentially create a new and unified Moose membership where all members, male and female, would have equal opportunities, rights and privileges within the Lodge. Nearly, 77% of the delegates voted in favor of moving to a unified Moose membership, easily surpassing the 67% majority necessary for adoption.

The changes are scheduled to go into effect on May 1, 2021 and will impact the membership in the following ways:

For the Lodge:

- Women will become members of the Lodge automatically on May 1, 2021. Women may become elected to the Board of Officers beginning May 1, 2022; however, qualified women may be eligible or appointed to open positions on the Board or to committees beginning May 1, 2021.
- Individual title changes will occur for the lodge officers, including "President" for Governor; "Vice President" for Junior Governor; "Chaplain" for Prelate and "Past Lodge President" for Past Lodge Governor. Any member, man or woman, may serve in the new positions as long as they are a member of either the Moose Legion or the newly structured Women of the Moose, or join within 60 days,
- All previous honors will transition seamlessly to the new integrated Moose. i.e. Any member receiving the honor of Past Lodge Governor shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of any Past Lodge President of The Moose.
- The revised Laws for Moose Social Quarters and Homes (Section IV) eliminates the House Committee; those duties will now be performed by the Lodge's Board of Officers.
- An Executive Session has been added to every Board of Officer's meeting, if necessary, to discuss confidential topics (i.e. personnel matters, legal matters, etc.), including issues previously handled by the House Committee.

For the Chapter:

- The Women of the Moose will be structured similarly as the Moose Legion; as an affiliated unit of the new Moose lodge.

- The WOTM will maintain all honors, charitable focus, lower dues and influence.
- Chapters will retain their current assets, without turning monies over to the Lodge.

Similar to the Moose Legion, women have the option of joining the Lodge without having to join the Chapter.

Some of the changes to the WOTM General Laws effective May 1, 2021 are as follows:

****4 Chapter Officers:** Senior Regent, Treasurer (renamed from Recorder), Secretary (renamed from Secretary/Treasurer) and Junior Past Regent (renamed from Junior Graduate Regent). The Junior Past Regent is an office of condition and is not elected.

****The new Senior Regent or Presiding Officer will appoint 4 Chairmen:** Membership, Fraternal Activities, Mooseheart/Moosehaven and Higher Degrees.

****A quorum for a chapter meeting will be 5 attendees, including 1 officer. A quorum for a Board meeting will be 2 officers.**

****A minimum of one (1) chapter meeting will be required each month.**

WOMEN OF THE MOOSE NEWS

All members must be in ACTIVE status on or before May 1, 2021 to ensure a smooth transition to One Moose!!! Anyone in arrears of their dues on May 1 will NOT receive 3 free years of dues in the Women of the Moose. You must be an ACTIVE member to receive the FREE 3 years dues.

ELECTION

Marinette Chapter 1900 Nominating Committee is forming and will be meeting in February. 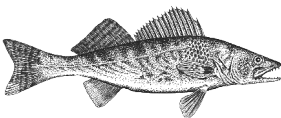


FISH FRY
